ORDER

There are three dispositive motions pending in this action, each of which this Court has thoroughly considered. Plaintiffs—*i.e.*, the Federal Forest Resource Coalition, American Forest Resource Council, Blueribbon Coalition, California Association of 4 Wheel Drive Clubs, Public Lands Council, National Cattlemen’s Beef Association, American Sheep Industry Association, Alaska Forestry Association, Resource Development Council For Alaska, Inc., Minnesota Forest Industries, Inc., Minnesota Timber Producers Association, California Forestry Association, and Montana Wood Products Association, Inc. (collectively, “Plaintiffs”)—have filed a [40] Motion for Summary Judgment; Defendants Secretary of Agriculture Tom Vilsack and the

United States Forest Service (collectively, “Defendants”) have filed a [42] Cross-Motion for Summary Judgment; and Intervenor-Defendants Klamath-Siskiyou Wildlands Center, Oregon Wild, the Wilderness Society, and Defenders of Wildlife (collectively, “Intervenor-Defendants”) have filed a [43] Cross-Motion for Summary Judgment.

Upon consideration of these motions, their oppositions, and the entire record of this case, and for reasons that will be explained fully in a forthcoming Memorandum Opinion, it is hereby

ORDERED that Plaintiffs’ motion for summary judgment will be **DENIED**; Defendants’ cross-motion for summary judgment will be **GRANTED**; and Intervenor-Defendants’ cross-motion for summary judgment will be **DENIED AS MOOT**. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that this case shall be **DISMISSED**.
